Boer War (1899-1902)

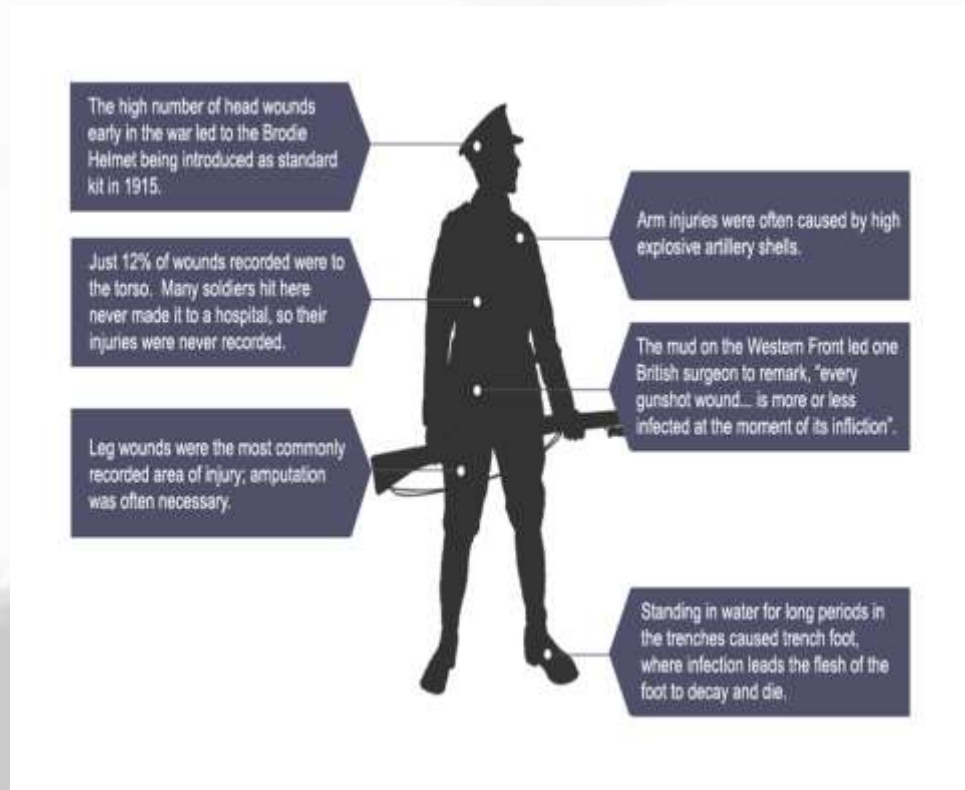
Water bed to reduce surgical shock

- *Ambulance system to evacuate soldiers*
- *Sanitary divisions to reduce risk of disease*
- *Use of Ray machines*
- *Field dressings implemented.*



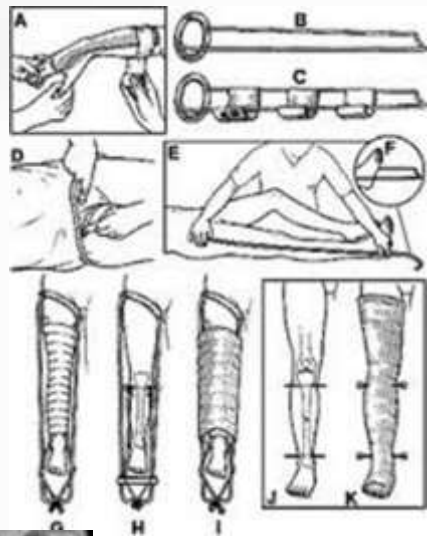
World War One 1914-18

Blood transfusion in Ambulance Car



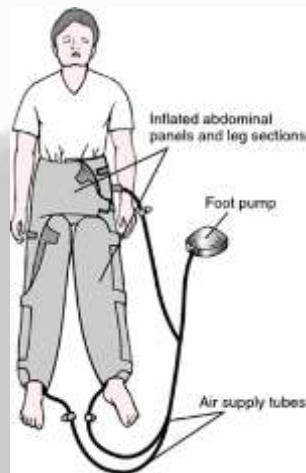
World War Two (1939-1945)
